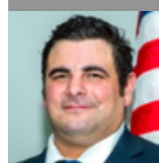

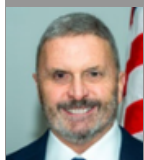
Vice Commodore's Corner

I am looking forward to seeing everyone at the regatta. This is our club's largest function of the year and will be successful with your participation!



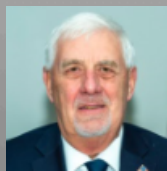

Pool Area - The swimming pool will be busy. For everyone's safety, glass is not permitted in the pool area.

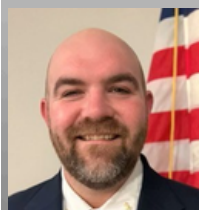

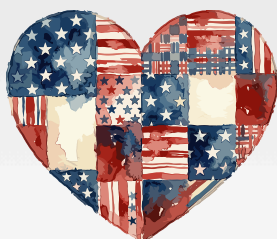
